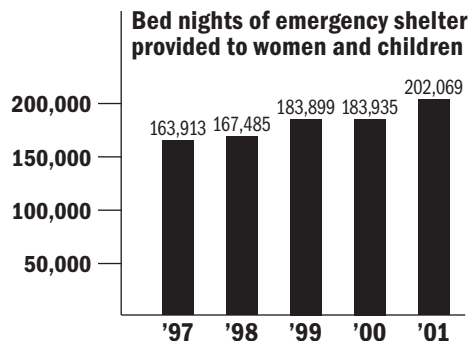
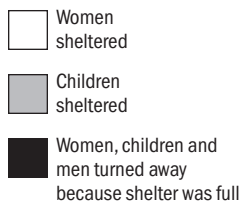


More battered women and their children served by MCADV members in 2001

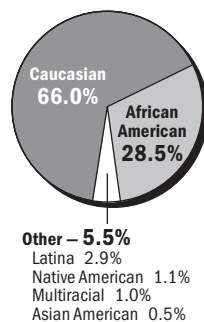
Approximately 8 percent more battered women were sheltered in 2001 as compared with 2000, according to data voluntarily submitted by 50 MCADV member programs that provide **emergency shelter and other services to victims of domestic violence**. In addition, more than 18,335 individuals received a wide range of non-residential services at no charge from 67 MCADV member programs that submitted data in 2001.



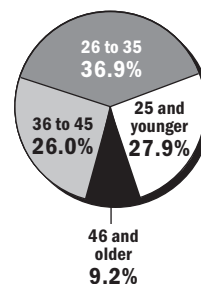
MCADV member programs provided **non-residential services** to 14,480 women, 3,538 children and 317 men in 2001.



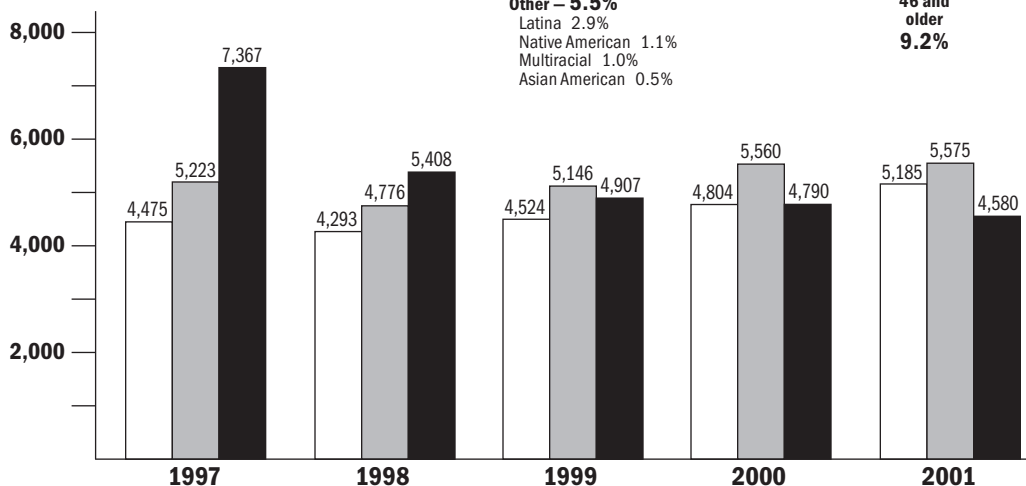
Ethnicity of women sheltered in 2001



Ages of women sheltered in 2001



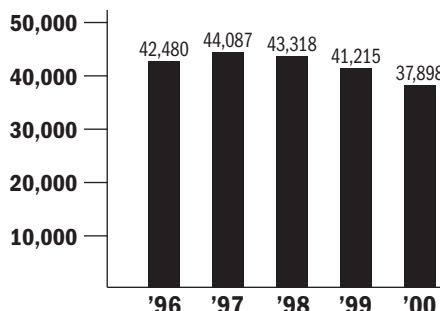
MCADV member programs provided 32,536 bed nights of long-term **transitional housing** to 155 women, 198 children, and one man in 2001.



MCADV member programs provided 110 bed nights of **emergency shelter to 11 men** in 2001.

Reported incidents of domestic violence continue to decline in Missouri

The Missouri State Highway Patrol annually compiles¹ incidents of domestic violence, whether an arrest is made or not, from statistics **voluntarily** submitted by law enforcement agencies in the state. Nationally, the U.S. Department of Justice estimates that about half of the incidents of intimate partner violence experienced by women are reported to the police.²
