



Therapist Openings at Hope House!

Hope House is seeking clinical/behavioral health professionals to join our effort to end the cycle of domestic violence and help survivors heal from the trauma of abuse. Therapists at Hope House provide clinical counseling and care to survivors of domestic violence. We currently have both full-time and part-time positions available.

- **Location:** On-Site at Independence Campus (limited remote work may be available)
- **Part-Time, Non-Exempt, Hourly Opening**
 - **Starting Rate of Pay:** \$27.16 - \$36.77/hour, dependent upon experience
 - **Schedule:** 15-20 hours per week. Requires availability of 2-3 weekdays each week, including at least one evening; two evenings are preferred. Weekends are generally not allowed.
- **Full-Time, Exempt, Salaried Opening**
 - **Starting Rate of Pay:** \$54,000/year (additional pay commensurate with experience)
 - **Comprehensive Benefits Package:** includes paid time off (29 days/year as a new employee), free employee-only health insurance, and free in-house clinical supervision
- **Schedule:** 40 hours per week + rotating on-call support

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide immediate crisis intervention, safety planning, and behavioral health assessments
- Develop individualized treatment plans and monitor progress
- Provide regular individual therapy to a caseload of clients
- Provide clinical case support services to survivors
- Facilitate psycho-educational and/or support groups
- Maintain clinical files and documentation according to legal and ethical standards
- Complete progress notes, treatment plans and summaries, outcome measurement tools, and other required documentation
- Participate in ongoing supervision



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Master's degree in Counseling or Social Work
- Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) or Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) in the state of Missouri
- Provisional licenses will be considered if the candidate is actively pursuing full licensure and is under appropriate supervision

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Bilingual (English/Spanish)
- Experience working with survivors of domestic violence
- Certifications in trauma-informed therapeutic modalities (EMDR, TF-CBT, DBT, etc.)

WORK ENVIRONMENT

This position is typically on-site at our Independence campus and may work remotely dependent upon client needs and supervisor approval. Therapists frequently interact with individuals experiencing trauma, crisis, or emotional distress.
